Since 1981 Sarah's Inn has been first of all a leader in helping families impacted by domestic violence find safety, rebuild their lives, and heal. But alongside this crucial mission, Sarah's Inn has steadily developed a broader vision of how to prevent violence and how best to intervene early to interrupt it and limit trauma. Preventing violence is the goal of the Together Strong school curriculum, which teaches healthy, nonviolent, and respectful relationships for middle and high school students. In partnership with local stakeholders, Sarah's Inn also delivers education and training programs for more effective community-level responses to violence.
