

Meanwhile, the following is from the Pilgrim Donut Committee:

1. Please have your volunteers bring their **own hats and masks**. Ball caps, kerchiefs, any type of hat is fine as long as it reliably stays on the head. We have a few clean items if someone forgets theirs, but it's best if people bring their own.
2. **Indoor workers must wear masks**. Outdoor workers are strongly encouraged to do so.
3. **We do not allow anyone into the building except our volunteers** for the day, so please do not bring family members with you, who will not be working.
4. Children 12 and over are fine in any position outside the kitchen. Everyone in the kitchen (fryer, mixer, fryer's assistants and trayers, as well as captains) must be 18 or over. Children under 12 can work as coaters and servers of donuts and drinks, but they need to be mature enough to work steadily and without a lot of oversight for three hours. Children under 10 need to be under the direct supervision of a parent or designated adult.
