

## Second Tuesday November Meeting recap

This was a thoughtful, in-depth conversation about the OPRF master facilities plan, the long-range vision for how to modernize OPRF for current and future needs in a prioritized, coherent, and cost-effective way over time. This was the last public discussion before the Work Group presented the plan and accompanying documentation to the D200 School Board on November 15.

This was a very well received event with many favorable comments made at the end. Perhaps the most useful was the explanation of the process followed to create the master plan, including public input, visits to area High Schools, careful research into options, and expert consultation. Community misperceptions were also dispelled such as how a master plan is different from a construction project, how the plan front loads academics, not athletics, and why rebuilding the athletic center will be the most costly.
