Beginning Tuesday, August 30

The Free English and Citizenship Preparation Classes at St. Philip Benizi, will begin in August. You MUST register on Tuesday or Thursday, August 13 and 15, 7:00 p.m. at the Hartmayer Education Building, Upper Level before attending classes. Classes are for immigrant Adults 18years of age or over. If you are interested in the Citizenship Test Preparation class, you must have a current US Permanent Residency Card (Green Card). Classes begin on Tuesday, August 20, 2019 from 7:00-9:00 p.m. and end on December 19, 2019. CHILDCARE IS NOT PROVIDED.
