A Nature Week is a week-long program, Monday through Friday. Days start at 9 a.m. and end at 3 p.m. Fees are as follows and include a t-shirt and journal that your child will create. Financial aid is available.

- *Explorer Week 1 and Explorer Week 3 – Explorer Week 9*—The fee per week is \$225; the fee for each additional sibling is \$210; and for those with a family membership, the fee is \$200 for each child, including the first.
- *Explorer Week 2*—The fee is \$180; the fee for each additional sibling is \$168; and for those with a family membership, the fee is \$160 for each child, including the first.
- Extended care is available from 8 to 9 a.m. and from 3 to 5 p.m. at \$10 per hour per child.

Please make your check payable to Frosty Drew Memorial Fund and mail your application and check to P.O. Box 160, Charlestown, RI 02813. You may also apply and/or pay online at <http://frostydrew.org>.

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. In order for your application to be considered, payment must be received with your application. You will be notified of your child's acceptance by mail.

If you find that you need to cancel your child's Nature Week, please let the Nature Weeks Director know as soon as possible. Note, no refund will be given if a child is withdrawn within one week of the start of his or her Nature Week unless the space can be filled.
