

Beef Breeding Project Enrollment and ID Form

Youth **MUST** be enrolled in the beef breeding project in 4honline by **March 1**.

Beef breeding project members must either submit their breeding beef ID paperwork to the Extension office before Beef Tag-In (March 2), or upload information into your 4honline, or submit paperwork the day of Beef Tag-In (March 2).

To fill out your Breeding Beef ID online, go to: co.4honline.com, sign in, go to your name, click “edit”, then “animals/livestock”, choose “Beef”, “Breeding Beef”, then click add animal. Fill out information and save.

- Upload the “2019 Douglas County 4-H/FFA Breeding Beef Registration Information Form (Non-Market Cattle)” – this form should be uploaded in the “County Use Form-Breeding Beef” section.
- Upload a color photo showing any distinguishing characteristics and ear tag if applicable. (One photo required, but two are available).
- Upload your registration papers (from a breed association) or your brand inspection papers. Note: These MUST be in the 4-H members name only! A breed registration form is acceptable in the member’s name and you do not have to get a separate brand paper. If breed forms are not in your hands, brand papers are required.

Please read the note on the bottom of the form about animals not born yet.
