Three Gratitudes

Ever so briefly at the end of the day.

A fine rain,
A good friend,
Fresh basil and wild phlox,
My father’s good health,
My daughter’s new job,
The song that always makes me cry,
Always at the same part,
No matter how many times I hear it.
Decent coffee at the airport,
And your quiet breathing,
The stories you told me,
The frost patterns on the windows,
English horns and banjos,
Wood Thrush and June bugs,
The smooth glassy calm
of the morning pond,
An old coat,
A new poem,
My library card,
And that my car keeps running
Despite all the miles.
And after three things,
More often than not,
I get on a roll and I just keep on going,
I keep naming and listing,

Until I lie grinning,
Blankets pulled up to my chin,
Awash with wonder
At the sweetness of it all.”

German theologian Meister Eckhardt is often quoted as saying this:

“If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough.” ---Meister Eckhardt

Gratitude is often the starting point I suggest to folks who express having difficulty connecting with God in prayer. In the poem you just read by singer/songwriter Carrie Newcomer, the author recommends listing three things every night.

But I know the reality of life is that sometimes even one thing is hard to come up with, so just start there! Use a real pen and put it down on paper. Try doing one every day. Then, maybe a week, or a month, or even a year later, move up to two things. There is no set timetable.

Eventually, you will find that the more you practice gratitude, like a rolling snowball, the more things you will begin to notice you’re grateful for.

This month, I’m going to create a Facebook post each week inviting you to add things in the comments for which you are grateful. For those who are not adept at social media, I’ll put up a display inside the church someplace yet-to-be-determined that can serve the same purpose.

“Gratitude begets gratitude, just as love begets love,” writes one of my favorite authors, Henri J.M. Nouwen, and wouldn’t you agree our world could use a lot more love?

So please join me this month in the practice of cultivating gratitude, either privately or communally. It could even spark a wave of love that spreads further and faster than the coronavirus, gossip, misinformation, or hateful political rhetoric, and *maybe* even repair some of the damage we’ve incurred as a society in the process.

I pray it does.

YOUTH

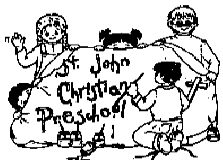
