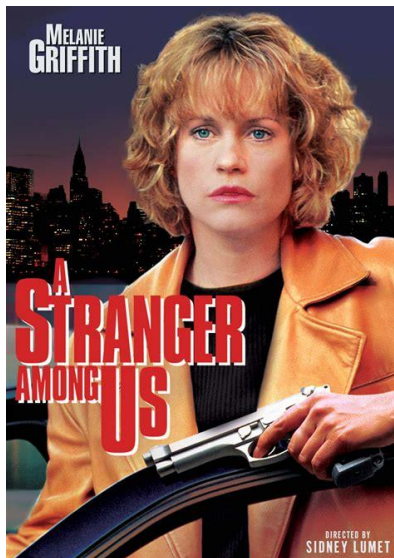

A Stranger Among Us is a 1992 American crime drama directed by Sidney Lumet and starring Melanie Griffith as a New York detective with a reputation for acting first and asking questions later. Assigned to investigate a disappearance connected to a jewel robbery, she finds herself in the middle of a closely knit community of Hassidic Jews.

The Big Fix

The Big Fix is a 1978 American political comedy thriller. It stars Richard Dreyfuss as private detective Moses Wine. Moses Wine is a 1960s radical who, in the 1970s, has gone into the private gumshoe game because it's one way to keep his integrity. His wife has left him because he refuses to become a lawyer. She's moved in with a trainer for an est-like outfit. Moses takes two-bit cases, investigating fraud at a poultry-packing plant, until this blond dame from out of the past walks into his life again and makes his heart feel like the escalator just stopped.
