



Grown-Up and Me introduces young children (ages 2–5) and their families to the joys of Judaism while fostering a supportive, vibrant Jewish community. The class meets monthly and explores a Jewish theme through music, stories, movement, and hands-on crafts designed to engage young learners and their caregivers together.

This program is open to both members and non-members and serves as an accessible entry point for families who are curious about Jewish life and may be interested in joining a synagogue community. Families may enroll in individual classes or purchase a discounted package of five classes.

Through Grown-Up and Me, we hope to make North Shore Jewish Center a welcoming home base for young Jewish families in the area and to build lasting relationships that encourage continued engagement in Jewish life.
