

## AIDS and Behavior COVID-19 call

AIDS and Behavior is seeking articles from ongoing HIV research during the COVID-19 pandemic on its impact on the lives of people living with and those at-risk for HIV. We are seeing impacts of COVID-19 on the entire HIV continuum of care/prevention. We will be publishing a series of 'Notes from HIV Research in the Era of the COVID-19 Pandemic'. Notes will be reviewed by the Editor and Associate Editors on the basis of three criteria: (1) applicability beyond any one study, (2) issues of immediate importance, and (3) quality of writing. Notes are not expected to present data, but any supporting objective information or data will be viewed as a significant strength. Notes should be no more than 1500 words of text, include a title and reference, but no abstract. Notes will be reviewed within 3 days of receipt and, if accepted, will be published through an expedited production system. Notes submitted should be of very high quality. Notes that require substantial revision will not be considered a high priority for publication.
