

The FCCC Spring Concert will take place on Saturday, May 12 at 7:00 P.M. at the Klein Memorial Auditorium in Bridgeport. The program will feature our special guest, Nick Page! Nick has been the FCCC's most frequent guest artist, and you will discover why on May 12! We will perform eight of his compositions, including a Mother's Day tribute written specifically for this concert. We will open the concert with a new arrangement of *Will the Circle Be Unbroken*, and we have a special group of alumni who will perform *Sing Me to Heaven*, as they did at the wedding of two FCCC alums last summer! The grand finale will feature all 300 plus singers of the FCCC and many wonderful selections.

On May 28 the FCCC Chamber Singers will be joined by thirty of our younger singers and choirs from across America in a performance of *Carmina Burana* by Carl Orff at Geffen Hall (formerly Avery Fisher Hall) at Lincoln Center in New York. This is a great opportunity to sing this major work on stage at the world-famous Lincoln Center with a professional orchestra!

The final event of the 2017 – 2018 season is the Chamber Singers tour to California from July 6 – 15. This ten-day tour promises to be one of the best the FCCC has ever experienced. Musically, the Golden Gate International Children's and Youth Choral Festival is the most outstanding music event we have ever attended, always attracting choirs from around the world. An added event this year will be our collaboration with the South Bay Children's Choir in Los Angeles. The educational and sight-seeing opportunities on this tour will be amazing, including visiting two major cities and driving up the California coast from Los Angeles to San Francisco, with all of the incredible locations we will see along the way. This will be our third visit to the Golden Gate Festival.
