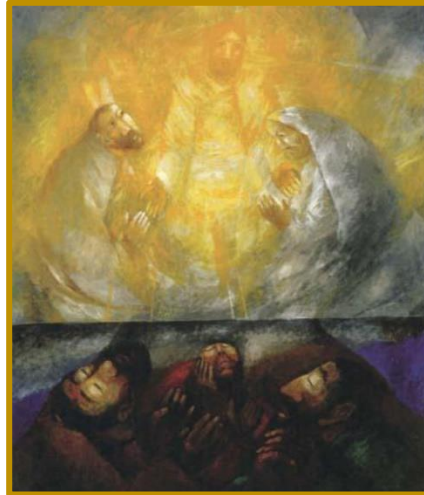

**PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE**

Pastor Tracy: Creator God, you are beyond our knowledge and understanding. We are full of wonder at your presence, and your revelation in your son, our Savior, Jesus Christ. As we enter a presidential election year that will be full of hateful rhetoric and division, please empower us, your people, to be bearers of love. Help us balance your desire for justice and equality with your call to care for our neighbors. May our churches be spaces of welcome where we can have faithful conversations that develop and deepen all of our understanding. Please be with our political leaders. Grant them the gifts they need to address the needs of our community.

**People: King of kings and Lord of lords, hear our prayer.**

Pastor Tracy: Almighty One, your Word tells us time and again how you care for the poor, the abused and the cast out. We pray for those people now. We pray for those who are homeless. We pray for those who are poor and struggling to make ends meet. We pray for new immigrants to this country seeking asylum. We pray for the lonely. We pray for the sick. We pray for grieving. We pray for the cold and the hungry. If we are to play a role in providing these needs, loving God, spark our hearts toward action.

**People: God of unlimited compassion and love, hear our prayer.**

Pastor Tracy: Lastly, God, we lift up our specific community. We pray for all those on the Prayer Concern list in our Sunday Bulletin. We know that you see us and hear us, and so it is in the name of Jesus Christ that we pray together:
