

SAME STORE SALES (Source: Compass RCR)

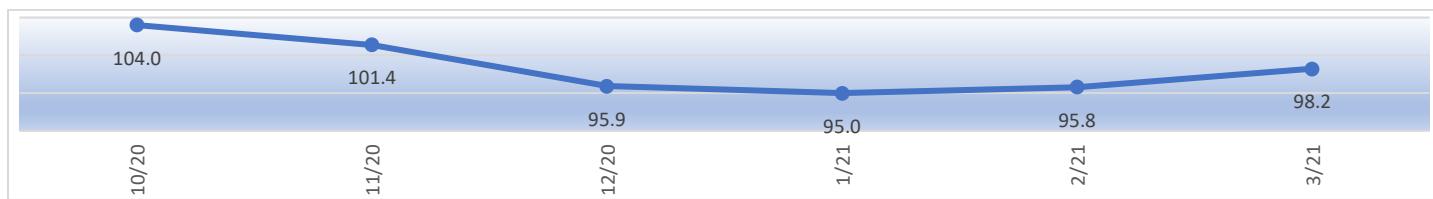


COMMENTS: March SSS showed better than expected results (for most chains recovery). Primarily influenced by weak comparisons and the new Stimulus payments to consumers.

March Optimism Index rose 2.4 points driven by the overall improvement in SSS recovery.

CONSUMER SENTIMENT (University of Michigan-Sentiment)

Consumer Sentiment rose 6.2 points. This improvement was primarily the results of an increased sense of safety with more people being vaccinated against the Covid virus, the general reduction in daily Covid cases across the country, and the receipt of the new Stimulus checks.
