

Paper Flower

Supplies:

Scissors or a large circle hole punch
yellow paper
paper in a variety of colors
stick glue
green paper drinking straw
clear tape (or patterned for some fun)



First cut or punch a few circles out of yellow paper. You will need one circle per flower.

Cut strips of paper. The length of your strip depends on the size of your circle. To determine this, first make one strip of paper and make a loop and see if it works with your circle size. Once you are happy with the size of the loop in relation to your yellow circle, start cutting strips of paper in that size.

Glue the ends of paper strips together, making a paper loop. You will need quite a few (the number depends on the size of the flower you are making).

Glue the loops on one side of the paper circle. We started by sticking 4 at a 90° angle, then another 4 in between and another 8 in between those.

Once you are happy with how full your paper flower craft is looking, apply some glue onto the green paper straw and press it in the middle of the back of the flower.

Secure with clear tape.
