## A BILL

To amend the Northern Border Security Review Act to require updates to the northern border threat analysis and northern border strategy, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Northern Border Secu-
- 5 rity Enhancement and Review Act".

1	SEC. 2. NORTHERN BORDER THREAT ANALYSIS AND
2	STRATEGY.
3	(a) Northern Border Threat Analysis.—Sec-
4	tion (a) of the Northern Border Security Review Act (Pub-
5	lic Law 114–267) is amended, the matter preceding para-
6	graph (1), by striking "180 days after the date of enact-
7	ment of this Act" and inserting "September 2, 2026, and
8	biennially thereafter".
9	(b) Northern Border Strategy Updates.—The
10	Northern Border Security Review Act is amended by—
11	(1) redesignating subsection (c) as subsection
12	(d); and
13	(2) inserting after subsection (b) the following
14	new subsection:
15	"(c) Northern Border Strategy Updates.—
16	Not later than 90 days after each submission of the threat
17	analysis required under subsection (a), the Secretary of
18	Homeland Security shall update the Department of Home-
19	land Security's northern border strategy. If the Secretary
20	determines no such update is required, the Secretary shall
21	submit to the appropriate congressional committees a noti-
22	fication relating thereto.".
23	(c) Classified Briefings.—The Northern Border
24	Security Review Act, as amended by subsection (b), is fur-
25	ther amended by adding at the end the following new sub-

- 2 days after each submission of the threat analysis required
- 3 under subsection (a), the Secretary of Homeland Security
- 4 shall provide to the appropriate congressional committees
- 5 a classified briefing regarding such analysis.".

- 7 OMMENDATIONS.—Not later than six months after the
- 8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Home-
- 9 land Security, acting through the Executive Assistant
- 10 Commissioner of Air and Marine Operations (AMO) of
- 11 U.S. Customs and Border Protection, shall develop per-
- 12 formance measures to assess the effectiveness of AMO at
- 13 securing the northern border between ports of entry in the
- 14 air and maritime environments.
