Young persons who were losing hope of gaining meaningful employment grow immensely in confidence and attain a more positive can do attitude, backed by practical skills in sailing and seamanship plus certification in swimming, First Aid/CPR and basic customer service training they can enter the workplace and not only fit in but thrive. Now in its seventh year the programme continues to enjoy a strong relationship with Saint Lucia's private sector maritime industry, with most graduates gaining employment within the sector and wider tourism industry on graduation.



Jus' Sail are proud to bring this award to Saint Lucia to help build the island's reputation as a destination that is committed to responsible tourism practices that enhances the contribution of the tourism industry towards sustainable livelihoods for its residents.
