From the Desk of Barrington Township Supervisor D. Robert Alberding



Barrington Township has provided funding for human needs and mental health support through a range of programs and services that benefit residents.

Directly or indirectly, the Township's elected officials recognize the need for social support to be made available to residents of our community through services in-house or by providing financial funding support to local organizations. Some of the local organizations which will receive grant funding in 2023 are Journeys/The Road Home (homelessness), Rahab's Daughters (rescue and rehabilitation of human trafficking victims), BACOA (senior social services, LIHEAP, lending closet), Barrington Youth and Family Center (mental health services), Little City (intellectual/developmental disability services), Children's Advocacy Center (child abuse intervention and recovery), Access to Care (health care services for uninsured or underinsured), NISRA (recreational activities for those with disabilities), Center for Enriched Living (intellectual/developmental disability services).

We have contracted with PACE to continue offering low-cost rides to our residents in 2023. Simply call Pace 24 hours in advance for your \$2 each way ride. We also offer Taxi coupons to our Senior (65+) or Disabled residents. The coupon is worth ½ the fare of your ride up to \$8. Please register at the Township for your 10 coupons per month.

For our residents that are facing life-threatening hardship, potential eviction or utility disconnections, financial assistance may be available through Barrington Township Emergency Assistance program, or temporary ongoing aid through General Assistance.

Cook County 2023 First Installment Bills due April 3, 2023.

2022 EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS will be available online the first week of April. Exemption applications have been in a roll-over mode for the last couple of years. The County will be busy sending out postcards, applications, and flyers regarding exemptions in the next few weeks. This is what you need to know:

Senior Freeze, Veteran and Disabled Persons Exemptions: No more roll-overs

Anyone seeking these 2022 exemptions must reapply in 2023.

General and Senior Homestead Exemptions If you receive a postcard from Cook County that states, NO ACTION required. *This means you do NOT need to apply for your General &/or Senior Homestead.*

- If you need help with your online application, please call our office, we will be happy to help you apply.
- If you receive any information from the County and you still have questions, give us a call or email us and we will find out for you what you need to do.
