About the Position

SCCAP's New Fund Development position is responsible for the creation, implementation and success of an annual fund development plan for the agency. The successful candidate must be able to cultivate and support donor relationships, grow an annual fund, utilize direct mail and social media, and support the philanthropic side of events. This individual will be charged with helping SCCAP develop a culture of philanthropy.

Working directly with and reporting to the CEO, this individual must be committed to our mission of *empowering families and engaging the community to pursue innovative and effective solutions to break the cycle of poverty*. The individual must be passionate about fundraising, be able to motivate and equip board members, staff and volunteers to embrace the philanthropic culture. They must be able to inspire donors, be comfortable sharing our mission and vision, be able to identify and cultivate key relationships, and solicit and close major gifts. SCCAP, located in Adams and Franklin Counties in Pennsylvania, has a staff of 106 and works with more than 2,000 volunteers. We support a wide array of both micro and macro level work designed to, with our partners, create communities where all families can thrive!

On the micro level we work with families through homeless shelter services and homeless prevention, weatherization of houses, Women, Infants and Children's Program (WIC), child care resource and referral and subsidy services, food pantries and access to gleaned fresh produce, job training and work to help families build a better future. SCCAP serves 32,000 individuals each year, about 10% of our communities' population.

On the macro level we take what we are learning from the families and communities we serve to inform system level work. We coordinate community coalitions around reentry services; around housing, transportation and wages; around food security working with local farmers and producers coordinating volunteers to rescue nearly 300,000 pounds of produce annually; we are also formalizing partnerships with health systems to identify gaps and ways to more systematically work together for better outcomes. We also host community films and panels inviting partners to join us in bringing important issues to the table for discussion to begin creating community change.
