**Disclosure:**

- A) The game of soccer is a highly aerobic and aggressive activity consisting of intense physical contact between players.
- B) The game of soccer requires it's participants to be in good health, to be physically fit and to maintain a basic level of physical conditioning.
- C) Be advised, as in all sports, soccer player injuries can and do occur. Bruises, broken bones and knee injuries have occurred in prior league competition.
- D) Catholic School/Christian Academy Soccer has an open gender format and therefore is Co-Ed in nature. Boys will be competing against girls.
- E) Catholic School Soccer has 2 competitive divisions; JV (which consists of grades 3,4 & 5) and Varsity (grades 6,7 & 8).
- F) Be advised therefore, that 5th grade boys can compete against 3rd grade girls and 8th grade boys can compete against 6th grade girls.
- G) Because of the open gender format, ceratin rules have been enacted to minimize on field collisions and reduce the potential for injury. Please be advised however that injuries can and do occur.
