Dear Woodland Family:

I want to share some important information regarding the upcoming bond election that will have a tremendous impact on our school and our school district.

The Fayetteville Board of Education has requested a special election to be held on **February 11, 2020** to request voter approval of a bond restructuring program. With voter approval and **NO MILLAGE INCREASE**, the district will restructure eight existing bonds to generate approximately \$111 million to address facility needs across the district, including renovation and upgrades of facilities, energy efficiencies, land acquisition and construction of a new school. These upgrades will impact every student in every school and facility across the district.

With voter approval, the impact of these funds will be felt here at Woodland with over \$1 million dedicated to building improvements. Additionally, students will benefit from the construction of a non-competition practice track.

All of our students will continue to benefit from district-wide upgrades and improvements as they move through our district in years to come. A detailed description of the priority improvements is available on the [district website](#). A few highlights include:

- *the addition of air conditioning in all middle school gymnasiums,*
- *the purchase of land and construction of a new school building,*
- *an athletic and academic facility renewal surrounding Harmon Stadium at Fayetteville High School.*
