All Faiths Food Bank In partnership with All Faiths Food Bank, FPC provides food to an average of 100 families each Thursday morning. Your donation feeds our hungry neighbors.

Beth-El Farmworker Ministry promotes self-sufficiency for rural migrant population in the Tampa Bay area through worship, education, and services to meet basic needs.

Caritas is a cooperative effort of five churches in downtown Sarasota that provides temporary emergency help (also food and clothing) to those who are in acute financial need .
