

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Ohio Department of Health has a requirement for vaccination for meningococcal disease for all incoming 12th-grade students in the State of Ohio.

All students entering the 12th grade must have 2 vaccinations for meningococcal disease (MCV4). The second dose must be administered on or after the 16th birthday and there must be 8 weeks between the first and 2nd doses. If the first dose is given after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

To prevent your child from being excluded from school this fall, we ask that you contact your physician to document the administration of this vaccine or to make an appointment for your child to receive this vaccination. Please return the bottom portion of this form to the High School Clinic by the first day of your child's Senior Year **or** turn in a complete copy of your child's immunization record from your physician or My Chart.
