

# Rev. McMiller's Ordination for Italy

**A few weeks ago I celebrated my ordination into the Pastoral Office.**

Needless to say, it was one of the most important days of my life. As I think back on my years of church work (the Dominican Republic, Mexico, Illinois and Wisconsin), I am thankful for my experience and I look forward to future service as a Pastor in Italy.

Personally, the most exciting part of the work in Italy is the four men in three cities studying to be Pastors. In front of Michael is Luiz who lives in the Northeast Corner of Italy. **Luiz is also studying to be a Pastor and has been a member of the Lutheran Church in Italy for 5 years...** one of our oldest members! In front we have **Lorenzo (front left) and Joshua (front right) who are old friends.** Lorenzo is working hard on putting together the first ever Lutheran hymnal in Italian. Joshua, on the other hand, moved to Italy when he was 12 years old and prayerfully considers being a Pastor to both Italians and the very large Pakistani community in Italy. Both Joshua and Lorenzo live in Rome.

As I continue to create a network of supporting Christian individuals and congregations across the United States, my family and I are thankful for all of you.
