PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINING

The demand for Pharmacy Technicians continues to grow due to the availability of new medications, national shortages, aging populations and the establishment of certified technicians. Pharmacy Technicians are vital in ensuring daily pharmacy operations run smoothly. Some of the duties performed include:

- receive and confirm prescription orders
- prepare and fill prescriptions
- provide excellent customer service
- manage inventory by counting and stocking medications
- process paperwork and insurance claims

This remote program prepares students to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) Exam. Upon successful completion of the certification exam, students must register with DHHS as a Pharmacy Technician. Additionally, students in this program will receive career coaching to improve their soft-skills by earning their work ethic and customer service certifications. Approximately 70 hours of this program is facilitated online. Interested candidates should have access to a computer and internet.

Interested candidates must be 18 years of age, have a High School Diploma or GED and never been convicted of a drug-related misdemeanor or felony.
