What is the MCC Cares Scholarship?

The MCC Cares Scholarship is a one-time scholarship for up to \$1,100 that can be used towards short term training programs or an Associate Degree. Upon completion there is an expectation that you will be gainfully employed full-time.

Eligibility details

To be eligible for the MCC Cares Scholarship you must meet the following guidelines:

- Employment must have been affected by COVID-19
- Have a current NEworks account
- Have a registered social security number
- Provide unemployment insurance benefit recipient information
- Commit to entire training program
- Be willing to be gainfully employed full-time upon program completion

What Programs can I enroll in?

There are select programs you can enroll in at MCC to use the MCC Cares Scholarship. The first step in selecting a program is meeting with one of our Career Skill Coaches. Here are the available I.T. programs:

- Cisco Networking or Cyber Security
- Computer Programming or Database Administration
- Data Center Ops or Server Administration
- Front-End or Full-Stack Web Development
- Instructional Technology & Design
- Office Technology or I.T. Technician

- Step 3: Select a program with your Career Skills Coach to enroll into
