Legal Aid of Nebraska has a **free legal help hotline** available for Nebraskans affected by COVID-19

- Is your landlord trying to evict you?
- Has money been taken (garnished) from your bank account or wages to pay a judgment for a debt?
- Has your stimulus payment from the federal government been taken (garnished) from your bank account?
- Have you been denied unemployment benefits?
- Have you been denied Medicaid, SNAP, ADC or other government assistance?
- Are you a victim of domestic violence or elder abuse?
- Have other civil legal issues as a result of COVID-19?

Nebraskans who have questions or are experiencing legal problems due to the coronavirus/COVID-19 public health emergency now have an easy way to get legal advice and help. The free COVID-19 Disaster Relief Hotline is available to Nebraskans affected by COVID-19 and in need of legal assistance.
