POSITION: Instructor/Assistant Instructor (Center Director/Lead Teacher)

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education (ECE) with 21 semester hours in courses related directly to childcare and/or child development from birth to age six and three years paid experience in licensed pre-school environment. The appointment will be at the rank of assistant instructor with a bachelor's degree and at the rank of instructor with a master's degree.

This is a security-sensitive position. Before any offer of employment is made, the University will conduct a pre-employment background investigation, which includes a criminal background check.

DUTIES: Major center duties include oversight of operations and compliance daily of a center, including classrooms, facilities, and transportation. Provide leadership through supervision, guidance, and mentoring to assigned center staff. Coordinating with area staff to ensure integration of service, monitoring and record keeping. Maintain a program of developmentally appropriate classroom instruction and provide a safe and nurturing environment in accordance with the Head Start Performance Standards, Program Policies, and Department of Children and Family Services. Major classroom duties include implementing daily lesson plans, conducting developmental screenings and assessments, referrals, conducting parent teacher conferences and home visits.
