

Western Governors' Leadership Institute Young Tribal Leader Nomination Packet

Thank you for your interest in nominating a young tribal leader to the Western Governors' Leadership Institute.

The Western Governors' Leadership Institute is a project of the Western Governors' Foundation. The program is designed to recognize and reward the effective exercise of leadership by young adults across the West, and to promote and encourage its future development.

Leadership delegates will attend a special leadership forum in Boulder, Colorado on June 25 - June 26, 2023, followed by the Western Governors' Association Annual Meeting, June 25 -July 28, 2023. The Western Governor's Foundation will pay all expenses associated with delegate participation.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must reside within the land mass of the following areas: Alaska, Hawaii, Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho, Kansas, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, Montana, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Oklahoma, Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa, or Guam.
- Nominees must be an enrolled member of a Federal or State-Recognized Tribe at the time of application submission.
- Applicants must be between the ages of 21 and 25 years old on July 26, 2023.

How to nominate an outstanding young tribal leader?

Nominations will be accepted from mentors and others who have observed leadership potential and a commitment to service in the delegate.

Submit a completed nomination packet which includes:

- 1) Part A: Nominator's Form
- 2) Part B: Nominee's Form
- 3) Two letters of recommendation from individuals not related to the nominee must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. (Pacific Time Zone) on **February 15, 2023**, to Doreen Hauser-Lindstrom, doreen@wsu.edu. These letters should be sent directly from the references. They should be written by individuals who know the nominee well and can speak to their character, leadership qualities, and future potential. *Please ask the references to submit all materials in PDF file format*
