Building a Tour Career with David Howell – David is a former top 10 player in the world, has been a winning team member of 2 Ryder Cups, and has won a number of top tournaments including beating Tiger Woods when he was World No 1 head to head to win a WGC event in Shanghai, China.



Power and Distance with Lee Cox – Lee is the no 1 Coach in the world for Long Driving and coaches not only World Long Drive Champion's but also PGA and European Tour Players how to increase distance. Lee will give tips and drills to help increase distance.



Wedge Zone with Steven Orr – Steven is a Master PGA Coach, and is current Head Coach of the England Boys Team. Steven did a research project involving Dr Rob Neal and the Rand A on the critical keys for great Wedging (50 to 100m). Steven will outline keys concepts and key drills to develop skills in this area.

A number of years ago, having failed myself to graduate from playing for England as a Junior to playing on the European Tour, I wanted to better understand the critical keys to success at Tour level, so I did a research project involving 50 Tour Player's, 7 of whom has been former World No 1s. One of the key findings from this research, was the power of 'vicarious experience'. Vicarious experience is a Sports Psychology term meaning 'if you can do it so can I'. Lee Westwood recalled to me how he was in a group of Juniors in his region in England and the success of the other players helped him believe he could do it. From his club there went to be 5 different players win on the

European Tour. Interestingly, this was almost present in all the journeys of the 50 players. So the idea of the WhatsApp group, is that I outline the successes, however small, of the different players in the program so each player can feed of each others success.
