Any student in grades 4-8 may be nominated by a faculty or staff member of District 20. Criteria for nomination include:

- *Students who exhibit excellent social emotional competencies throughout the school environment.*
- *Students who have participated and excelled in co-curricular and athletic programs and whom have exhibited qualities of hard work, perseverance, good sportsmanship, kindness, and willingness to help others.*

Students may be disqualified from consideration if they have any office referrals for negative behavior during the previous trimester.

Nominations will be reviewed and awards determined by the Collaboration and Communication Committee of the Board.
