Our Club:

Club Dues \$200: Required to be member in good standing. We have actual fees to Rotary District and Rotary International of \$131/year that is charged to our club plus operational expenses such as guest lunches, supplies, Rotary International Convention and PETS for presidents, fellowship and all other expenses associated with running the club.

Pledge \$250 strongly recommended: This money goes to ***our Clubs 501(c)3 Foundation*** and allows our club to do the good that we do. Such things as both inbound and outbound exchange students, the Rotary Track meet, high school scholarships, international and local grant matching, community grants, RYLA student leadership program, among others.

Duck Race \$250 to purchase a Super Quack Pack: This money supports the Rotary Duck race which is a project of all 4 area clubs who in the past years have raised more than 1.5 million dollars which go back into our community for such projects as Reinhart Volunteer Park, Morrison Park, All area High School tracks, The Food Bank, Wildlife Images, Boys & Girls Club, and The Josephine County Fairgrounds.

Rotary International: all funds count toward the Paul Harris Society

Polio Plus, Suggested annual donation of \$100 as Polio Plus Society member: to support the effort to eradicate Polio worldwide.

International Contributions, Suggested annual contribution \$200: To support Rotary International efforts in six areas of focus: to promote peace; fight disease; provide clean water, sanitation, and hygiene; saving mothers and children; supporting education and growing local economies.
