## Job Description

The WOUB Public Student Media Lab is seeking students to work in broadcast and digital production technical crew positions. These entry level internship/practicum positions involve hands-on training and operation on approved WOUB productions - *NewsWatch*, *Gridiron Glory*, *Hardwood Heroes*, *The Bobcat Sports Showcase*, *Ohio University Homecoming Parade*, *WOUB TV pledge* and support of other video productions.

Crew positions include studio and field camera operation, teleprompter, audio set-up and operation, floor managing and basic studio lighting maintenance.

Technical crew members will work with advanced-level technical crew members to complete broadcast productions. All video production technical crew will be supervised by WOUB professional staff members.

## Minimum Qualifications

Ideal candidates should have prior knowledge of video production workflow in single or multi-camera productions. Must be able to work with minimal supervision, demonstrate strong communication skills, be on-time and conduct themselves in a professional manner.

Video editing, DSLR camera operation, basic lighting and audio skills desired.

Must have at least six hours available per week after 4:30 p.m. Friday evenings and Saturday mornings.
