Job Description

The WOUB Public Student Media Lab is seeking students to work in broadcast and digital production technical crew positions at an advanced level. These internship/practicum positions have elevated responsibilities and managerial duties for approved WOUB productions - *NewsWatch*, *Gridiron Glory*, *Hardwood Heroes*, *The Bobcat Sports Showcase*, *Ohio University Homecoming Parade*, *WOUB TV Pledge*, and support of other video productions that involve up to ten technical crew members.

Crew positions include Ignite coding and directing, assistant director duties and video editing supervisor.

Successful candidates will have the ability to provide technical direction, provide feedback to entry level technical crew and work closely with news or sports producers. Directors will lead a nightly newscast produced by the WOUB news department or a 30-minute sports studio production in a HD production control facility. Assistant directors and video editing supervisors support directors in preparation of studio productions, and they are able to train to become a director. All technical crew will be supervised by WOUB professional staff members.

Minimum Qualifications

Ideal candidates should have advanced knowledge of audio/video production workflow in single or multi-camera productions. Television broadcast experience is preferred. Premiere editing and video file management skills recommended. Must be able to work with minimal supervision, demonstrate strong communication skills, be on-time and conduct themselves in a professional manner. Prior leadership or managerial experience is recommended.

Must have at least six hours available per week preferably after 4:00 p.m., Friday evenings and Saturday mornings.
