Friends of Scouting: The Chesapeake District Friends of Scouting campaign continues to be important to help provide local Scouts the best outdoor and fundamental program possible. There are several ways you can help with Friends of Scouting. Unit presentations and becoming a presenter are just a few!

- **Presenter:** A volunteer that helps with the Family Friends of Scouting Campaign reach the districts goal by visiting units.
 - *Responsibilities:*
 - 1. Attends presenter orientation meeting
 - 2. Contacts the assigned units and confirms the date, time, and location of the presentation.
 - 3. Makes the unit presentation to each of the assigned units.
 - 4. Turns in prospect cards to District Executive in a timely manner after the presentation.
- **Unit Presentation:** Each year units allow district volunteers to give a presentation about the good things that are happening in Scouting and ask for support from the unit's friends and families.
 - *Presentation Options:*
 - In- Person: District volunteers attend a meeting, Court of Honor or Blue and Gold to give a short presentation.
 - Virtual Presentation: This is a similar idea to an in person presentation, except this will be during a virtual meeting. A unit can choose to have the presentation during a committee, parent or unit meeting.
 - Scouting Gives: This is a personalized webpage for a unit. It includes a specific FOS goal, unit message and unit picture. The link can be emailed or shared with family and friends.
