District COVID Reporting Updates

We continue to be encouraged by the way our units are finding ways to continue Scouting. As this new way to operate becomes familiar, and we grow comfortable with the process for in-person meetings, let's continue to be vigilant in the care in the execution before, during, and after the event. Especially remind attendees of their obligations after. [The Restart Scouting Checklist](#) reminds us:

When you get home:

- Avoid contact with higher-risk individuals for 14 days.
- Monitor for any signs of illness for 14 days, and
- Communicate with your unit leadership should you develop symptoms.

If someone does experience symptoms, elects to have a test because they or a family member has symptoms, or has a positive test, please also view this as an incident requiring official reporting. The checklist states:

- In case of an injury or illness, promptly report the incident, including COVID-19 exposures. Utilize Incident Reporting Resources (<https://www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/incident-report/>) , including COVID-19 instructions.

So, emphasize to your attendees their obligation to report to the unit after the event. And remember the Unit's obligation to report to the Chartered Org, and to the




District. This week's news is dire due to the number of cases, but there is hope with the progress in vaccine development. Breathe in the hope.

Online Registration Update

Now users are able to transfer from one Scout unit to another without having to take a new application into the Scout office. On the “My Application” tab you can transfer yourself as an adult volunteer or your youth member from unit to unit. Unit leaders will be able to transfer youth by going to the new “Roster” feature in “Member Manager” and “Organization Manager” and select the youth who need to be transferred, then click the “Transfer” icon. This will create a transfer application which will be sent to the new unit with the ability to be approved in “Application Manager”. Transfers will take 48 hours to sync with the new unit.

The “Roster tool” also allows unit leaders to email other leaders in the unit directly from the tool. Editing youth/adult profiles, and printing rosters/membership cards is also available in the updated tool.
