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HIGH SCHOOL MISSION TRIP

GENERAL INFORMATION:

In July 2019 our high school students will participate in a mission trip to the coastal area of South Carolina. This trip is available to all students (youth & young adults- grades 9 and up).

THE NEED:

The area of South Carolina where we will be working was hit hard by Hurricane Florence in September of 2018. The subsequent flooding lasted for more than a month. Many homes were lost completely and others still sit unoccupied because of the high cost of repairs. There are also many other needs not related to the hurricane/flooding.

WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

One of our church members, Mary Grey Moses, who is also the Director of the Centenary program, grew up in this area. She connected us with a gentleman named Jeff Davis who is the director of the Salkehatchie Summer Service Camp in Conway, SC. Fortunately for us, part of his job is to find work projects for mission groups! He has found someone who is in need of a wheel chair ramp. Our group will travel to South Carolina, buy the materials, and

build that wheel chair ramp!

HOW MUCH WILL THIS TRIP COST?

The cost per participant is \$250 plus expenses. There is limited room for this trip. Therefore, a \$50 non-refundable deposit will hold your space. Breakfast & Lunch will be provided each day. Participants will be expected to pay for dinner each night and all meals on traveling days (Sunday, July 7th and Saturday, July 13th) and our free day (Friday, July 12th). That is a total of 11 meals.

Students may also want to purchase drinks, snacks, etc. We recommend a minimum of \$150 per person to cover all meals and for miscellaneous spending money.

LODGING:

We will stay in a rented house in Cherry Grove which is located in North Myrtle Beach. Pictures of the "Davis Beach House" may be viewed here: <https://www.footprintsatthebeach.com>

Boys and girls will stay in separate rooms of course. There is beach access less than quarter mile away (at the end of the street). Everyone must bring their own pillow and linens or sleeping bag.

PREPARATION FOR THE TRIP:

There will be a parent's meeting on Sunday, June 30, 2019 immediately after the morning worship services in the Student Center Lounge. All participants and one parent (if participant is a minor) are required to attend this meeting.
