Mrs. Maria O'Connor is thrilled to continue at directing at Blessed Sacrament. She will be rejoined by Ms. White and Mr. Pringle from last year. Mrs. O'Connor also directs, acts and light designs around town, and teaches theater at Imagination Stage. She is passionate about including the students in the creative process and making it a fun and fulfilling experience for all. Mrs. O'Connor's goals are to teach theater skills while fostering growth in creativity, confidence, teamwork and friendship.

Kindergarten-4th grade:

Join the chorus! Chorus members will attend two rehearsals, the afternoon of the dress rehearsal, and both performances. They will learn 2-3 group songs to sing with the cast. This is a great introduction to theater and there is no need to audition. The cost of participation is \$30 per child.

5th-7th grade:

Join the ensemble! They will be singing, dancing, and acting onstage in groups of characters. Ensemble members will attend about half the rehearsals. There is no need to audition, just register and then come to the first rehearsal on February 5th. The cost is \$40 per child.

8th grade:

Star in the show! The show is a culmination of the 8th grade year and a bonding experience for the whole class, so all 8th grade students will participate on or offstage. 8th graders who wish to act should attend auditions on January 29th and will attend most rehearsals, depending on their character. 8th graders who don't want to act may help backstage, build sets, or help on show nights. The cost of participation for actors is \$50 per actor (and free for non-actors).
