Categories of Nomination

Volunteer in Action/ Community Volunteer

Criteria: Spends time at school site, makes lasting contribution, serves as positive role model, receives no compensation from district.

Volunteer in Action/ Service Group

Criteria: A nonprofit group which creates awareness for education in community, makes impact and lasting contribution, serves as positive role model, provides support for education.

Partners in Education/ Small Business or Franchise

Criteria: Creates awareness for education in community, makes impact and lasting contribution, serves as positive role model, provides support for education.

Partners in Education/ Corporation or Government Agency

Criteria: Creates awareness for education in community, makes impact and lasting contribution, serves as positive role model, provides support for education.

Excellence in Education/ Education Professional

Criteria: Employed by or represents a public education institution (from list at bottom right), exemplifies educational values, makes impact and lasting contribution, serves as positive role model, respected by peers, contributes to their profession.

Excellence in Education/ Student Alumni

Criteria: Contributes to their profession, contributes to their community, received education in San Bernardino County, recognized in the public eye, continued interest in public education.

Please review the categories on the left and explain in a **typed** narrative not exceeding 1,000 words why you feel the person or organization nominated is deserving of this honor. Judging will be based primarily on this narrative and should address the criteria as noted for the category you feel represents your nominee. Supplemental materials are limited to three pieces and may include a resume, testimonial letter, news clipping, etc.

The awards committee reserves the right to redirect nominations to categories it deems most appropriate. Previous winners may be renominated after 10 years. **Incomplete nomination forms will be disqualified.**
