

Do This!

1. Plant right plant, right place.
2. Build healthy soils builds healthy plants.
3. Use soaking hoses instead of spraying.
4. Plant a diverse set of plants for more resiliency and supporting predators such as parasitoids, who are the most important biological control a gardener has method and they don't sting:

5. Buy Bee Safe Plants that are NOT treated with Neonics.
6. Try to tolerate some plant damage so insects have a place to live too.
7. Lure predators to handle pests in your veggie garden by planting Sweet Alyssum, Yarrow, Coreopsis, Fennel, Dill and Parsley.
