Fire Island Pines Refuse District Collection Schedule & Guidelines

- Solid Waste Collection (Includes Commercial Pickup Locations)
 - Mondays: March through November
 - Thursdays: April through September
- Recycling & Bulk
 - Wednesdays: March through November
- Winter Pick-up (December through February)
 - No house-to-house collection. Two containers are provided and labeled, located West of Harbor Walk on the South side of the Boulevard. The first is for garbage – please use a sturdy, tied black bag. The second is for tied paper and cardboard. Metal cans and 1&2 plastics can be mixed – please use clear, tied bags. No loose material please!
- Holidays: No collection, will be re-scheduled to the next business day

Pick-Up Location: Please make sure all items are placed in front of premises, adjacent to & not more than 5 feet from the nearby public walkway by 6 a.m. on day of pick up. Please cover containers tightly to discourage intrusion from animals. Brownie Companies is not responsible for the removal of loose debris left inside sheds and/or gatehouses. Containers must be limited to 50 lbs. for the safety of the attendants.

Bulk Items: Items will be collected separately on bulk collection days. Brownie Companies is not obligated to take railroad ties, dirt, concrete, hot tubs, propane, or acetylene tanks. Mattresses and box springs must be placed in plastic mattress disposal bags. Please contact us for special bulk arrangements.

Construction Debris: Construction debris is limited to 3 cans or bags per residence per week and must be limited to 50 lbs. Construction debris must be a product of work performed by the homeowner and not a hired contractor. Please contact us for separate container service for construction contractor projects.

Landscaping Debris: Small pieces of landscaping may be placed in sturdy plastic bags. Branches must be tied/bundled no larger than 4' x 2' for collection. Limit 50 lbs. Loose yard waste will not be collected nor will sand, soil, grass or stumps. Landscaping debris must be a product of homeowner performed work, not a hired contractor. Please contact us for separate removal service for landscaping contractor projects.

Recycling: Place the following items in your recycling container. Excess recyclables may be placed in clear plastic bags only. Additional approved containers, if desired, are available for purchase from the Town of Brookhaven. Glass is no longer a recyclable item and should now be discarded as solid waste.

- Metal Cans
 - Rinsed clean; labels, caps, and lids need not be removed. Do not crush. Aerosol spray cans are acceptable with plastic caps removed.
- Plastic Containers (#1 PETE & #2 HDPE)
 - Rinsed clean, look for number in triangle symbol on bottom of container; labels, caps and lids need not be removed.
- Aluminum Foil & Foil Pans must be rinsed and crumpled
- Paper Products
 - Packed in brown paper grocery bags or tied in bundles with twine; no plastic bags nor plastic string/wire. Acceptable mixed paper includes newspapers, mail office paper, catalogs, color inserts, magazines, envelopes, sweepstakes, copy paper, forms, school paper, construction paper, book pages, index cards, post-its, legal pads, wrapping paper (non-metallic), greeting cards, NCR paper, phone books, shredded paper.
- Corrugated Cardboard must be flattened and tied with string (no plastic tie/wire)
