ABOUT SMS

Spokane Mobility Services (SMS) has sought to solve the mobility needs of our community for over forty years. Now, we're coordinating free food distribution across Spokane county – utilizing volunteers to transport directly to households.

DESCRIPTION

In collaboration with the Spokane County Food Security Coalition, SMS and our pilot partners were awarded CARES Act funding by the County Commissioners to address the unmet need of folks with mobility issues not having access to emergency food in the wake of the COVID-19.

OBJECTIVE

We will deliver at least 47,000 pounds of food provided by 2nd Harvest! Feeding 2,000+ families and seniors over the course of December's pilot. We will create the infrastructure to scale for a fully food secure Spokane. Additionally, we will collect the stories of the people who use our program and create a story map to depict how people are affected by food insecurity in our region right now and how they are impacted by our program.

OPPORTUNITY

COVID-19 has made food insecurity worse. With the help of partners like the The Zone, their dedicated Community Health Workers and holistic approach, translation and ensuring culturally appropriate service, Jewels' Helping Hands and New Hope Resource Center's trusted volunteers, and our allies across Spokane, together we can coordinate the effective distribution of food where it is most needed throughout Spokane County. Together, we too can understand and uplift the stories of those who became food insecure here locally because of COVID-19.
