To better serve you during Washington State's **Safe Start plan**, Parking Services has **relaxed enforcement of 72 HR time limits** for cars, trucks and motorcycles only. The City continues to serve our community by responding to and monitoring parking complaints, such as:

- **SAFETY HAZARDS**
- **DRIVEWAYS/HYDRANTS**
- **JUNK/HULK VEHICLES**
- **EXPIRED REGISTRATION**
- **OBSTRUCTION ISSUES**
- **NO PARKING ZONES**
- **ON-STREET TIME LIMITED PARKING**

BE AN ON-STREET PARKING PRO



PARK WITH THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC –
Parking in the wrong direction can create a big safety issue with oncoming traffic.



THERE IS A 24 HR LIMIT

For non-passenger vehicles to actively load and unload in neighborhoods.



PARK NEXT TO THE CURB – WITHIN 1 FOOT

If a vehicle makes travel unsafe, or poses a threat to public safety, it is subject to immediate impoundment.



DON'T FORGET TO PAY FOR PARKING –

Keep that spare change from your coffee and download the Passport Parking app to easily pay for parking touch-free!



NO PARKING ZONES –

Pretty self explanatory.



KEEP YOUR VEHICLE REGISTRATION CURRENT

It's 2020, FYI.

DON'T PARK ON CROSSWALKS –

In fact, always park 20 FT away.



DON'T PARK ON SIDEWALKS – Sidewalks are for pedestrian traffic only and doggos.



DON'T BLOCK DRIVEWAYS –

Always park at least 5 FT away from any driveway opening.



PARK 30 FT BACK FROM ALL INTERSECTIONS –

That includes stop and yield signs too.



PARK 15 FT AWAY FROM FIRE HYDRANTS and

definitely don't block them.



JUNK/HULK VEHICLES –

These are typically vehicles missing major parts, heavily damaged, or inoperable. Don't park or repair vehicles on the street.
