What kind of services does 2-1-1 refer to?

There are many services that 2-1-1 can refer callers to based on their needs, such as:

- **Basic Human Needs Resources:**
Food banks, clothing, shelters, housing and utility assistance
- **Physical and Mental Health Resources:**
Medical information lines, crisis intervention services, support groups, counseling, drug and alcohol intervention, rehabilitation, health insurance programs, Medicaid and Medicare, maternal health and children's health insurance programs
- **Support for Older Americans and Persons with Disabilities:**
Home health care, adult day care, congregate meals, Meals on Wheels, respite care, transportation and homemaker services
- **Support for Youth and Families:**
Quality childcare, after school programs, Head Start, family resource centers, summer camps and recreation programs and protective services
- **Volunteer opportunities and donations:**
