## CRADLE-TO-CAREER INITIATIVES



### Child & Family Advocacy

**Empowerment Center** provides resource navigation and case management through wrap-around support and education services.



### Family Stability

**Precious Essentials** provides basic essentials such as clothing, coats, shoes, household goods and hygiene items to families in need, and those facing crisis situations.

**Basics 4 Babies** provides basic essentials such as diapers, formula, wipes and baby gear to families with infants who would otherwise ration or go without these necessities.



### Academic Success

**Inspiring Minds** provides access to STEM-based activities to children through our Inspiring Minds Center and educational take-home STEM Kits.

**Ed essentials** provides educational support, such as computers, calculators, tutoring and incentives to improve educational outcomes.

**Fill A Backpack** provides backpacks filled with grade-appropriate school supplies to children in need to maximize their academic potential.



### Social & Emotional Well-Being

**giveARTS** provides support for arts program costs associated with lessons, participation fees, instruments and art supplies to children in need.

**giveSPORTS** provides new and gently-used sports equipment, along with support for sports program costs associated with registration, uniforms and participation fees.

**Precious Gift** provides gifts to children who would otherwise go without during monumental times in their lives such as birthdays and holiday celebrations.

**Precious Mentor** provides Peer-to-Peer, Community-Based Adult to Youth and Workforce Development mentorship to disadvantaged youth, focusing on Academic Achievement, Social Emotional Development and Workforce Readiness.



### Workforce Development

**Precious Perks** provides opportunities through A Precious Child's Social Enterprise Coffee and Gift Shop for young adults, 15-24 year-olds, helping them with training and obtaining employment.

## 2021 MEASURED GROWTH

QREM, a third-party evaluator, found that working with A Precious Child reduces a family's reliance on public assistance programs over time, representing approximately \$5.6 million dollars in combined diverted public assistance dollars for families receiving WIC, TFAP, SNAP and TANF services over two years.

## EMPOWERING CHILDREN

A Precious Child provides Colorado children in need with opportunities and resources to empower them to achieve their full potential. With cradle-to-career support, A Precious Child is able to break the cycle of poverty by reducing socioeconomic inequalities.

20,177 Backpacks with school supplies distributed • 92% of kids who received backpacks are more interested in learning  
16,412 Gifts distributed • 93% of caregivers feel closer to their children



### Because of A Precious Child's programming:

- 87% of children have better mental health.
- 84% of caregivers reported a reduction in stress.

## STRENGTHENING FAMILIES

### The families we serve face significant barriers, including:

- 28% of families have experienced homelessness within the last year.
- 33% of families have someone in the household who is diagnosed with a disability.
- 94% make at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- 99% fall below the Colorado Self-Sufficiency Standard.

Basic Essentials & Wrap-Around Services are provided through our main Resource Center and 50 Satellite Resource Centers across eight counties. Personalized resource navigation and case management are provided to families to meet the needs of the whole child.
