GUIDELINES

- All pieces must be the participant's original work. Plagiarized works will not be accepted.
- Artists may enter up to 3 pieces - Please follow submission instructions for each entry.
- Artwork may not exceed 11w x 17l x 20h inches in size.
- Acceptable art media are paint, pencil, markers, ink, crayon, chalk or pastel (fixed), and collage, three-dimensional pieces, computer printouts, video, photography, and photocopies.
- Do not fold artwork or use paper clips.
- Acceptable performance pieces: dance, creative writing, poetry, song, instrument, and theater (10 min. or less).
- Submissions may not include anything that is toxic, hazardous, or flammable.

WRITING AN ARTIST STATEMENT

An artist statement is a general introduction of your work as an artist. It is the what, how, and why of your work, from your own perspective. It helps you convey the deeper meaning or purpose of your work to the viewer.

We'd like to encourage artists to include a short statement of a paragraph or less with their entries. We want to have them indicate what inspired them to create this artwork. If necessary, this can be dictated or translated and typed by a teacher, parent, or caretaker.

This will be displayed next to your art for viewers to read.
Please limit artist statements to 500 words (one page).

The following is a list of possible questions that participants can use to reflect on their artwork and write their artist statement:

Why did you choose this idea to represent your work?

What are your sources or inspiration for this piece of work?

What type of media was used? Why?
