



Outreach Project Guidelines

2018-2019



The **Francis Marion University Center of Excellence to Prepare Teachers of Children of Poverty** will solicit proposals for the 2018-2019 Professional Development Outreach Project that addresses issues related to the education of children of poverty. Awards will be recommended primarily on the basis of merit rather than on the amount requested, perceived size of the project, or number of Principal Investigators (PIs) or Co-Principal Investigators (Co-PIs).

Categories and Overall Guidelines

- Awards for Educators of Children of Poverty that focus on the development or expansion of best practices or specific strategies for teaching children of poverty
- Research designed to study the population to validate issues regarding:
 - Educating Children of Poverty in the Pee Dee area educational community
 - Educating Children of Poverty in the State-wide educational community
- Projects will be funded for up to \$2,000 per Outreach Project.

The submission deadline for 2018-2019 awards is September 21, 2018.

Award decisions will be made by October 12 via email.

All projects awarded must be completed by May 1, 2019.

Proposal Guidelines and Restrictions

1. Center P-12 Professional Development Outreach Projects are open to Public School Educators (P-12) in Center Partner Districts. Proposals may be submitted by an individual or group from a public school district.
2. All Co-PIs must play a significant role in the proposed project.
3. PIs must submit a Project Completion Report to the Center Research and Professional Development Committee at the completion of the project by May 1, 2019.
4. Outreach Projects recipients must present project findings at a Center Workshop or Summer Institute within one calendar year of receipt of funding.
5. Only new project concepts will be funded. Projects or project concepts that have previously received funds through this project may not be renewed for additional years.
6. Preference will be given to projects that potentially will benefit the most children of poverty.

Application Format

Use the template that follows to submit your application. *Use the guidelines and headings listed below. Length is restricted to four single-spaced pages of text. (Tables and figures are not included in the page count.) Note that the significance of the purpose and objectives of the project must be clear and supported by information that is understandable to the non-expert.*

1. Center of Excellence Outreach Project Application Cover Sheet (Proposal must include all required signatures.)
2. Principal and Co-Principal Investigator's Previous Experience (List previous experiences with children of poverty or teachers.)
3. Purpose/Goal (Identify all project goals and explain the importance of each in detail.)
4. Project Summary (1-2 paragraphs that summarize the project)
5. Project Location/Sample (Tell where this project will be implemented.)
6. Background (Include sufficient background to explain the project clearly to non-expert. Specifically address the population of children of poverty that will be served by this project.)

Project Planning Chart (Identify each goal, related objectives, and time line for completion. Duplicate chart for multiple goals.)

7. Methodology/Project Planning Chart (Provide a narrative description of the project, including the role of any Co-PIs.)
 - a) Student Objectives (What specific outcomes are expected for students?)
 - b) Activities (What activities are planned to help you accomplish each objective?)
 - c) Schedule/Timeline (Show the approximate time frame for the implementation/completion of each objective.)
 - d) Assessment of (Student) Outcomes (Specify the assessment(s) that will be used to measure the success of each objective. Include the role of PI and Co-PIs.)
8. Budget Summary and Justification Form (Describe the specific purpose of requested funds for items listed on Budget Summary page of the Center Outreach Project Application Form.)
