School, Family and Community Partnership Outreach funds will be awarded to Public School Educators (PK-12) in Center Partner District schools that are members of the National Network of Partnership Schools on a competitive basis. Projects will be funded at amounts of up to \$1,000 for the 2019-2020 academic year, ending May 1, 2020.

The Fall 2019 deadline for submitting completed outreach applications to the Center School, Family, and Community Outreach Committee is August 30, 2019. Award decisions will be announced September 13, 2019. Awards will be determined by availability of funding.

2019 -2020 Application and Guidelines

The *Francis Marion University Center of Excellence to Prepare Teachers of Children of Poverty* solicits proposals for projects that address issues related to school, family, community partnerships and the education of children of poverty. Awards will be recommended primarily on the basis of merit rather than on the amount requested or perceived size of the project.

Outreach Categories and Overall Guidelines

- Outreach Funds for Educators of Children of Poverty must focus on the development or expansion of best practices or specific strategies for School, Family and Community Partnerships and teaching children of poverty.
- Submission deadline for 2019-2020 awards is **August 30, 2019**. Award decisions will be announced September 13, 2019. Final Project Completion Report for the grant is due May 1, 2020.
- Projects will be funded for up to \$1,000 per application.

Proposal Guidelines and Restrictions

- ❖ Family, School, and Community Partnership Outreach Funds are open to PK-12 Public School Educators in the **Center Partner Districts in schools that are members of the National Network of Partnership Schools**. Proposals may be submitted by an individual or group.
- ❖ **Proposals must be accompanied by the school's 2019-2020 National Network of Partnership Schools One-Year Action Plan.**
- ❖ Projects **must** be aligned with one goal from the school's One-Year Action Plan: academic, behavioral, or creating and sustaining a welcoming school climate.
- ❖ Successful applicants must submit a **Project Completion Report** to the Family, School, and Community Outreach Committee at the completion of the project, no later than **May 1, 2020**.
- ❖ Successful applicants must share their practice at the Center's NNPS End-of-Year Celebration - TBA.
- ❖ Successful applicants must submit the practice for publication in *NNPS Promising Partnership Practices 2020*. Submissions are due May 15 2020.
- ❖ Preference will be given to the practices that actively involve ALL parents and that potentially will benefit the most children of poverty.

2. Project Planning Chart

Project Goal

Select **one** goal from your 2019-2020 NNPS One-Year Action Plan for Partnerships:
one academic goal **or** one behavioral goal **or** one climate of partnership goal.

Examples:

Academic: improving reading, math, writing, science or other skills

Behavioral: improving student behavior, attendance, respect for others, safety, transition

Climate of Partnership: any goal that creates a welcoming school environment, strengthens and sustains a climate of partnership.

Desired Results/Expected Outcomes

What specific outcomes are expected for teachers, students, and parents?

Example: Academic Goal: Improve student reading skills

Desired Results: Students will increase their MAP scores in reading by 6-10 points.

a. Family and Community Involvement Activities/Methods

What **one or two** activities will be implemented to support the goal? In a few sentences, summarize the practice. Include information about who, what, where, and when—if it is a recurring event, say how often it was held.

Example: Used Book Sale –Involve parents as volunteers in organizing a used book sale. Solicit community organizations through donations of used books to conduct a special event where students can purchase low-cost books to read at home.

c. Assessments

Specify the assessment(s) that will be used to measure the success of the goal.

Complete at project conclusion only on or before May 1, 2020.
