## Volunteer Corner for May

- We have some transitional times in May! We change from the Easter season to Pentecost Sunday to Holy Trinity Sunday and then to the Pentecost season. ### Job Overview

- The Preschool Director is to promote a positive and engaging learning environment for students, families, and staff of the Redeemer Renaissance Preschool, which is part of the Redeemer Renaissance continuum of learning for children ages 1.5 – 12.
- The Preschool Director plans and administers a program that provides a developmentally appropriate education for preschool aged children in a Christian setting.
- The Director manages daily operations and activities including staffing, enrollment, curriculum, financials, marketing, safety, and outreach.
- The Director of RRP collaborates with the Redeemer Renaissance Executive Director and the Director of the Redeemer Renaissance After-School program.

The Redeemer Renaissance Preschool operates in accordance with the vision, mission, and guiding principles of the ministry and the Virginia Department of Education.

This is a full-time position, Monday through Friday, with benefits including health and dental insurance, life insurance, matching 403(b), paid time off, paid holidays, and professional development opportunities.
