## Exciting and Puzzling <br> based on Luke 24:1-12

Early on the third day after Jesus died, some women who were followers of Jesus took spices to the tomb where Jesus was. When they got there, the big stone wasn't covering the opening. When they walked into the tomb, it was empty! The women were puzzled.

Then two men in dazzling white clothes appeared. The frightened women hid their faces.
