

F.H. PERRY BUILDER COVID-19 WORK SITE PROTOCOLS FOR TRADE PARTNERS AND VISITORS

F.H Perry Builder is committed to the health and safety of all our employees and trade partners on every project. For the safety of all people on site, FHPB has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for violations, and appropriate actions – including removal from the job site – will be taken to enforce these policies.

Work Site Provisions

FHPB has gone to great lengths to prepare each of our job sites in a consistent fashion. Each site has the following items in place to ensure the safety of all individuals.

- Signage posted reflecting protocols and providing clear direction for proper adherence.
- Arrival station with sanitizing equipment, thermometer, and self-certification checklist.
- Backstock of PPE for emergency use.
- Hand washing and sanitary facilities.
- Disinfectants and a cleaning protocol to sanitize sites frequently.
- Division of spaces to allow for 6' distancing.

Work Site Requirements

- Trade partners will be required to provide their own PPE; however, FHPB will supply PPE and supplies in the case of emergencies.
- Mask wearing is mandatory indoors and is advised when outdoors. During all interactions that take place less than 6' apart, mask wearing is mandatory.
- Hand washing upon entry and exit is mandatory; wash with soap for at least 20 seconds in provided hand wash stations and/or use the alcohol-based hand sanitizer provided.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 6' from other individuals, including during breaks whenever possible.

Work Site Arrival Protocol

Upon arrival to the job site for the first time, a work site orientation will be conducted by the Project Manager to share with all workers the protocols and specifics of their site.

Upon arrival to the job site EACH DAY, all workers will be temperature screened by the Project Manager and will self-certify in writing that:

1. I have no flu-like symptoms, no signs of a fever or a measured temperature above 100.3 degrees, a cough or shortness of breath within the past 48 hours.
2. I have not had "close contact" with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19 or exhibiting flu-like symptoms in the past 48 hours.
3. I have not been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by their doctor or a local public health official.
4. I have been cleared by a Medical Professional to return to the work site if any COVID-19 symptoms were experienced.
5. I have traveled to work alone (walking or biking); by Public Transportation observing social distancing requirements; or in a private vehicle with no more than 2 people in it.

If anyone answers "No" to any of the above, they are NOT permitted to enter the site and must inform their supervisor and the Project Manager immediately.

Work Site Best Practices

- Each jobsite has developed frequent cleaning and decontamination procedures.
- Conducting meetings via phone/video calls whenever possible is encouraged (even from the next room).
- Multi-person activities will be limited where feasible.
